### Essential Questions-

I am looking for a connection to the Treaty of Versailles (Unit 6) as a contributing cause to the conditions in Germany that led to Hitler's rise to power. Give some specific terms of the treaty that Hitler used to help him gain support and how he eventually broke many parts of the treaty.

3. "Why is propaganda successful in shaping public opinion?"

I am looking for an explanation of what propaganda is and how it was used in WWII. Give specific examples of WWII propaganda and explain how it was used and what the intended effect was.
