

World War II Baseball Card Project

Task: you will create 10 “baseball cards” from the following list

Details:

-on the front of a 3 x 5 index card you will need the name of the person, a picture of the person and what alliance they were in (Axis or Allies), include their national flag during WWII. This may be done using digital presentation programs but must be physically submitted- no email, no Google Classroom, no sharing document. You may use school printers to print things out and use of black and white printers will not have any effect on grading

-back you will write down 6 facts about the person, you may include when, where they were born and died, job/ rank during World War II, their activities during the war and fun facts. You must select at least 2 American, 2 German, 1 British, 1 Japanese, and 1 Soviet leader and any other 3 people of your choosing. If you want to select someone not on the list they must be approved by me. You may make a card for a relative that served in WWII.

1 point for correct flag

1 point for person name

1 point for person picture

1 point for correct alliance

Back

6 points for facts (1 point for each fact)
